Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department's letters No.38020/(1)2005-FC.3 dated 20.12.2005 on the subject mentioned above and to say that consequent upon increase in the Quarterly Price Index average from 2641(1960-100) of the previous quarters to 2700 (59 points), the Department of Public Enterprises has further modified the rates of dearness allowance payable to the employees/Executives of the Public Sector Undertakings with effect from 01.01.2006 vide their O.M.No.2(9)/2000-DPE(WC)GL-II dated 17.01.2006 (Copies enclosed). Therefore, IDA Pensioners/Family Pensioners covered under the instructions contained in the Department's letters under A-38020/01/97-FC.3 dated 26.02.98 and A-38020/2/97FC.3 dated 01.06.98 have now become entitled for payment of Dearness Relief (IDA) at the revised rates w.e.f. 01.01.2006 onwards.

2. Accordingly, approval of the Government is conveyed for the payment of dearness relief to the IDA Pensioners/Family Pensioners of FCI at the following modified rates effective from 01.01.2006 onwards:-

<u>Effective date</u>	<u>Average of AICPI</u>	<u>Revised DR rates(%)</u>
01.01.2006	2700 (Increase over last Quarter 59 points)	58.1%

3. The payment of account of dearness relief involving fraction of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next rupee and the fraction of less than 50 paise may be ignored.
